#### **Corrected Poster Contest Information**

The Supreme Lodge has once again announced the Poster Contest for students who wish to make a poster. The topics have once again been changed to a different format. This contest has been re-worked and now has basically four divisions! The hand drawn and computer-generated divisions will be for 6 to 8<sup>th</sup> graders and the same for 9<sup>th</sup> to 12 graders. Supreme pays \$1,000 to win in each division! Indiana, in 2024, had one national winner and one runner-up! \$1,500 was made by these students plus state and local prizes! Get involved with your local schools! A great way to get the Knights of Pythias name out! The topic for 6<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> graders is "You Have A Friend In Me". For 9<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> graders it will be "Together We Stand". New this year...the person that sponsors the student...i.e. Art teacher, Librarian, 4-H leader, Scout leader, etc. will receive \$250 if their student places in the top four in the Supreme contests. Poster literature is being re-made and will be sent to all Lodge Secretaries & District Deputies and is available from the Grand Secretary. Entry deadline is April 1, 2025. #### **SCHOLARSHIP FORMS NOW AVAILABLE!!**

The 2025 Knights of Pythias Academic Assistance Scholarship Forms are available on the indianapythias.org state website! If you are a High School senior and are NOT Pythian affiliated, use the PUBLIC form. If you are a Pythian or related to a Pythian, use the applicable PYTHIAN form. If you have already been in the Pythian program, and are maintaining a "B" GPA, you have 4 years of eligibility. You MUST re-file EACH year using the PYTHIAN COLLEGE form. Regardless, always remember to include your two essays **and your transcript** from either high school or college. The new system is PDF fillable and is done on-line. When finished, hit the submit button. The program will send it to the Grand Lodge office.
